Property Maintenance

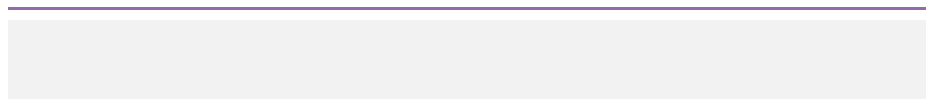
